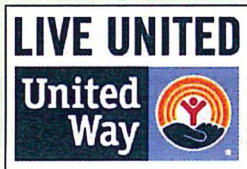

ABOUT WESLEY

Wesley Church Health Center, Inc. (WHC) is a community-based free clinic located in Connellsville, PA that offers integrated primary and behavioral health services for individuals and families in southwestern PA who are uninsured or for those with health insurance who find it difficult or impossible to meet their annual deductibles or afford their co-payments.

To provide free primary and preventative health care for uninsured and underinsured individuals and families



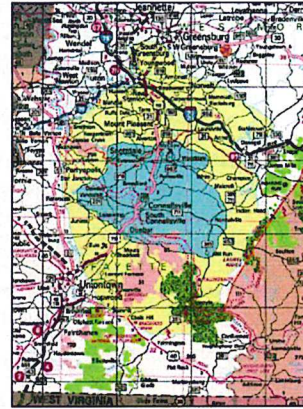
Since opening in 1993, WHC has provided safety-net services, treating acute and chronic illnesses, reducing emergency room visits, providing patient education to improve health conditions and reduce health risk, coordinating with health professionals and health facilities to increase services, and welcoming patients in an atmosphere of care and concern.

WHC is a non-profit, 501(c)(3) organization, governed by a volunteer Board of Directors, and supported almost entirely by grants, donations and fundraising.

WHO WE SERVE

WHC may be located in Fayette County but many uninsured who receive services at the clinic live in neighboring counties including Westmoreland and Somerset. You do **NOT** have to be a resident of Fayette County to receive health care services at WHC!



ELIGIBILITY

WHC serves individuals 19 and older in southwestern Pennsylvania without regard to age, ancestry, color, race, disability, national or ethnic origin, religion, sex, sexual orientation, veteran status, political affiliation, marital status, or ability to pay. **There are no income requirements to receive care at WHC.**

Our mission at WHC is to provide health care to those who may not be eligible for or who cannot afford health care anywhere else. **Services and programs at WHC are open to individuals who are uninsured or those with health insurance who find it difficult or impossible to meet their annual deductibles or afford their co-payments.**

In addition, individuals who may have primary care insurance but who do NOT have eye or dental insurance are eligible for free oral and retinal services at WHC.

WHC offers free health and wellness services and education programs such as:

- REFERRALS
