Wesley Church Health Center, Inc. (WHC) is a community-based free clinic located in Connellsville, PA that offers integrated primary and behavioral health services, as well as dental and eye screenings for individuals and families in southwestern PA who are uninsured or underinsured.

Since opening in 1993, WHC has provided safety-net services, treating acute and chronic illnesses, reducing emergency room visits, providing patient education, coordinating with health professionals and health facilities to increase services, and welcoming patients in an atmosphere of care and concern.

ELIGIBILITY



WHC serves individuals 19 and older in southwestern Pennsylvania without regard to age, ancestry, color, race, disability, national or ethnic origin, religion, sex, sexual orientation, veteran status, political affiliation, marital status, or ability to pay. There

are no income eligibility requirements to receive care at WHC.

Our mission at WHC is to provide health care to those who may not be eligible for or who cannot afford health care anywhere else. Services and programs at WHC are open to individuals who are uninsured or those with health insurance who may have problems meeting co-pays or annual deductibles.

In addition, individuals who may have primary care insurance but who do NOT have eye or dental insurance are eligible for free dental and eye screenings at WHC.

HOW CAN EMPLOYERS HELP

As a small business owner, you can help your employees stay healthy by providing them with information on WHC. Copies of our WHC brochure are available free of charge for you to distribute to employees with paychecks or to have available in your human resources office for new employees.

If addition, your business can contract with WHC to provide your employees with annual physicals, health screenings, or to do flu shot clinics.
